	Employment After Retirement of School District Personnel: Provides that retired instructional personnel may immediately after termination become employed by school district as substitute teacher; authorizes retired instructional personnel to be reemployed as substitute teacher & continue receiving retirement benefits; provides requirements for such reemployment. Effective Date: July 1, 2019

Federal Immigration Enforcement; Prohibiting sanctuary policies; requiring state entities, local governmental entities, and law enforcement agencies to use best efforts to support the enforcement of federal immigration law; authorizing a law enforcement agency to transport an alien unlawfully present in the United States under certain circumstances; prohibiting discrimination on specified grounds, etc. Effective Date: Section 908.107, Florida Statutes, as created by this act, shall take effect October 1, 2019, and, except as otherwise expressly provided in this act, this act shall take effect July 1, 2019
- [SB 170](#)** **Federal Immigration Enforcement** Bean  
Federal Immigration Enforcement; Citing this act as the “Rule of Law Adherence Act”; creating provisions relating to federal immigration enforcement; prohibiting sanctuary policies; requiring state entities, local governmental entities, and law enforcement agencies to comply with and support the enforcement of federal immigration law; authorizing local governmental entities and law enforcement agencies to petition the Federal Government for reimbursement of certain costs; providing whistle-blower protections for persons who report violations; requiring repeal of existing sanctuary policies within a specified period, etc. Effective Date: Sections 908.302 and 908.303, Florida Statutes, as created by this act, shall take effect October 1, 2019, and, except as otherwise expressly provided in this act, this act shall take effect July 1, 2019
- [SB 174](#)** **Panic Alarms in Public Schools** Book  
Panic Alarms in Public Schools; Citing this act as “Alyssa’s Law”; requiring each public school building on the campus of a public elementary school, middle school, or high school to be equipped with at least one panic alarm, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2019
- [SB 182](#)** **Medical Use of Marijuana** Brandes  
Medical Use of Marijuana; Medical Use of Marijuana; Redefining the term “marijuana delivery device” to provide an exception to the requirement that such devices must be purchased from a medical marijuana treatment center for devices that are intended for the medical use of marijuana by smoking; redefining the term “medical use” to include the possession, use, or administration of marijuana in a form for smoking; restricting the smoking of marijuana in enclosed indoor workplaces; requiring a qualified physician to submit specified documentation to the Board of Medicine and the Board of Osteopathic Medicine upon determining that smoking is an appropriate route of administration for a qualified patient, other than a patient diagnosed with a terminal condition, etc. APPROPRIATION: \$2,596,664.00 Effective Date: 3/18/2019

Student Elopement: Requires public schools to create Staff Assistance for Emergencies (SAFE) Team & school elopement plan; provides requirements for team & plan; requires & provides requirements for elopement quick reference guides for certain students; requires public schools to annually submit their plans to district school board. Effective Date: July 1, 2019
- [HB 185](#)** **High School Equivalency Diploma Program** Valdes  
High School Equivalency Diploma Program: Provides for award of high school equivalency diploma to students who meet specified criteria relating to high school graduation requirements. Effective Date: July 1, 2019
- [HB 189](#)** **Postsecondary Education for Secondary Students** Zika  
Postsecondary Education for Secondary Students: Provides certain reporting requirements for certain postsecondary institutions; revises provisions relating to dual enrollment programs; renames Collegiate high school programs as early college acceleration programs; revises requirements for such programs. Effective Date: July 1, 2019
- [SB 190](#)** **Education** Stargel  
Education; Revising the academic terms in which certain students are eligible to receive Bright Futures Scholarships; removing a requirement for a Florida high school graduate to enroll in certain programs within 3 years of graduation from high school in order to receive funds from the Florida Bright Futures Scholarship Program; removing a limitation of 45 semester credit hours or the equivalent for an annual award for the scholarship program; expanding the eligibility for an initial award of a scholarship under the Florida Bright Futures Scholarship Program to include students who earn a high school diploma from a private school, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2019
- [SB 194](#)** **Higher Education** Stargel  
Higher Education; Requiring the Office of the Inspector General of the Board of Governors to verify certain information for

accuracy; requiring, by a specified academic year, Florida College System institutions and state universities to execute agreements to establish "2+2" targeted pathway programs; requiring district school boards to notify students about credit-by-examination and dual enrollment equivalency lists, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2019

<a href="#"><u>HB 197</u></a>	<b>Concealed Weapons and Firearms</b>	Polo
	Concealed Weapons and Firearms: Prohibits concealed weapon or firearm licensee from openly carrying handgun or carrying concealed weapon or firearm into any child care facility. Effective Date: July 1, 2019

	Impact Fees: Revises minimum requirements for adoption of impact fees by specified local governments; exempts water & sewer connection fees from Florida Impact Fee Act. Effective Date: July 1, 2019	
<a href="#"><u>HB 213</u></a>	<b>Immunization Registry</b>	Massullo, Jr.
	Immunization Registry: Revises provisions relating to communicable disease prevention & control program under DOH; provides that students who obtain vaccinations from colleges or universities may refuse to be included in immunization registry; requires submission of opt-out form & removal of information & records from registry; requires health care practitioners to report data to immunization registry; requires district school boards & governing authorities of private schools to establish & enforce policy for age-appropriate screening of scoliosis. Effective Date: January 1, 2021

	Postsecondary Education for Certain Military Personnel: Requires BOG & SBE to create uniform system for award of postsecondary credit to certain servicemembers & veterans of United States Armed Forces; provides process for award of postsecondary credit for military experience & credentials; requires specified postsecondary institutions to waive transcript fee for active duty members of Armed Forces of United States, certain veterans, & their spouses & dependents. Effective Date: July 1, 2019

	Education: Requires district school board to allow student to wear dress uniform of United States Armed Forces or National Guard at graduation ceremony. Effective Date: upon becoming a law

	Mastery-based Education; Renaming the Competency-Based Education Pilot Program as the Mastery-Based Education Pilot Program; authorizing a district school board participating in the Mastery-Based Education Pilot Program to award credit based on student mastery of certain content and skills; authorizing a district school board participating in the Mastery-Based Education Pilot Program to use an alternative interpretation of letter grades for certain students, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2019
